the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan of Brunei Darussalam was Yang Mulia Awg Hj Sabri bin Hj Mohd Taha, Head of Halal Industry Innovation Centre. Signing on behalf of SQW China Limited was Mr Gary Ho, Managing Director of SQW China Limited.

SQW Consulting, a qualified and established consultancy firm with regional and international experience in developing and managing agrotechnology parks, science

and technology parks and innovation centres, will work together with the Halal Industry Innovation Centre to establish a 500 hectare Agrotechnology Park at Kg Tungku, Mukim Gadong. The park will serve as a hub to support the development of the Brunei Halal brand, providing large industries and SMEs with infrastructures for research applications and innovative technologies, and able to accommodate laboratory buildings and offices.

19th APECSMEMM and 35th APECSMEWG, Russia

The 19th APEC Small and Medium Enterprises Ministerial Meeting (SMEMM) chaired by Mr. Vladimir Simonenko, Deputy Minister for Economic Development, Russian Federation, was held on 3 August 2012 in Saint Petersburg, Russia. The meeting, attended by ministers and representatives from 21 APEC Member Economies, had the theme "Promoting SME Cooperation for Innovative Growth in the APEC Region" and three sub-themes, namely: "Assisting SMEs in internationalisation and supporting the export-oriented SMEs"; "Fostering the Innovative SMEs", and "Supporting Start-ups and Young Entrepreneurship".

Brunei Darussalam was represented by Yang Berhormat Pehin Orang Kaya Seri Utama Dato Seri Setia Awg Hj Yahya bin Begawan Mudim Dato Paduka Hj Bakar, Minister of Industry and Primary Resources.



Points of note during the meeting:

- General consensus among ministers that advancing SME cooperation for innovative growth can be enhanced through promoting startups - considering that it is the most important stage of entrepreneurship;
- In cognizance of the importance of the inclusion of young entrepreneurs in economic activities, the ministers gave support to the Russian initiative in organising the 1st Young Entrepreneurs Network (YEN) held on August 2, 2012 in St. Petersburg, Russia;
- Ministers acknowledged internationalisation as an integral part of sustainable growth of SMEs and MEs - the development of trade relations between SMEs in the Asia-Pacific region is a driving force towards the common goal of integration and development of the economic potential of APEC;
- Corruption recognised as a bane that imposes significant market access barriers and high costs for SMEs. To address this, ministers have endorsed codes of business ethics for the medical device, biopharmaceutical, and construction/engineering sectors;
- Recognition of the contribution of

SME Working Group (SMEWG) towards implementing the SMEWG Strategic Plan 2009-2012. To continue the work of SMEWG, the ministers have endorsed the new four-year SMEWG Strategic Plan 2013-2016 which provides a roadmap to address critical issues pertaining to the growth of SMEs and micro enterprises (MEs) in the APEC region.

Within the context of the first two subthemes, Yang Berhormat Pehin Orang Kaya Seri Utama Dato Seri Setia Awg Hj Yahya bin Begawan Mudim Dato Paduka Hj Bakar, Minister of Industry and Primary Resources, shared Brunei Darussalam's initiatives on assisting internationalisation in supporting the export-oriented SMEs as well as in nurturing the innovative SMEs. The Minister also shared with forum congregants the challenges Brunei Darussalam faces as a small country with a small population - possessing an economy fully-dependent on oil and gas; having limited market excess; and high costs of production.

Prior to this 19th APEC SMEMM, another related forum, the 35th Small and Medium Enterprises Working Group (SMEWG) Meeting, serving to update on the progress of projects undertaken by APEC SME member economies, was held from

1 to 2 August 2012. Brunei Darussalam's delegation to this meeting was led by Yang Mulia Dyg Hjh Normah Suria Hayati bte Pehin Jawatan Dalam Seri Maharaja Dato Seri Utama (Dr) Awg Hi Mohd Jamil Al-Sufri, Permanent Secretary of MIPR.
