Food Security Issues Discussed at 34th AMAF Meeting

The 34th Meeting of the ASEAN Ministers on Agriculture and Forestry (34th AMAF Meeting) was held on 27 September 2012 in Vientiane, Lao People's Democratic Republic (Lao PDR). Representing Brunei Darussalam was Yang Berhormat Pehin Orang Kaya Seri Utama Dato Seri Setia Awg Hj Yahya bin Begawan Mudim Dato Paduka Hj Bakar, Minister of Industry and Primary Resources and senior officials from the Ministry of Industry and Primary Resources (MIPR).

In the meeting which was chaired by His Excellency Mr. Vilayvanth Phomkhe,

Minister of Agriculture and Forestry of Lao PDR, the Ministers:

- Reaffirmed their commitment in ensuring that the ASEAN Community Blueprints' measures are implemented according to the strategic timeline; by intensifying their efforts in implementing these measures at both national and regional levels;
- Expressed their satisfaction on the good progress in the implementation of the ASEAN Integrated Food Security (AIFS) Framework and the Strategic Plan of Action on ASEAN

The Ministers agreed to remain vigilant to the opportunities and challenges of food security within the region and the world, particularly at a time of high volatility in commodity prices and economic uncertainties.

sector and civil society engagement in addressing food security in the region and urged close collaboration with other ministries, dialogue partners, development and international organisations in monitoring the progress of the AIFS Framework and the SPA-FS.

During the meeting, Yang Berhormat Pehin:

- Noted that, in the area of agri-food produce and food safety and quality, the harmonisation of standards and procedures among ASEAN member states will improve the facilitation of trade on these commodities;
- Expressed Brunei Darussalam's concern on the emergence and reemergence of zoonotic diseases which had hindered the development of livestock industries in the ASEAN region, concurring to the suggestion of the Additional Role and Functions of the ASEAN Sectoral Working Group on Livestock (ASWGL) and Senior Officials of AMAF in the Utilization and Management of the ASEAN Animal Health Trust Fund (AAHTF);
- 3. Stressed on the need to manage and conserve our forests and its

biodiversity for the social, economic and environmental benefit to the current and future generation. Yang Berhormat Pehin expressed the need for further strengthening of efforts at regional level within ASEAN, and also between the non-ASEAN countries to achieve this goal;

4. Expressed appreciation to dialogue and development partners for their efforts in executing some of the joint projects and activities, such as the ASEAN-US Cooperation on Maximizing Agricultural Revenue through Knowledge Enterprise and Trade (MARKET), German International Cooperation (GIZ), Asian Development Bank (ADB), the Southeast Asia Fisheries Development Center (SEAFDEC), the Food and Agriculture Organisation of the United Nations (FAO), the International Rice Research Institute (IRRI), World Organisation for Animal Health (OIE), etc.

During the 12th AMAF + 3 Meeting, Yang Berhormat Pehin also had the opportunity to meet his counterpart from the Republic of Korea; H.E. Mr. Sang-Kil Lee, Vice Minister, Ministry of Food, Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries, to discuss possible bilateral cooperation and collaboration in the field of agriculture, fisheries, forestry and the halal industries.

The Ministers agreed to meet again for the 35th Meeting of the ASEAN Ministers on Agriculture and Forestry in Malaysia in 2013.
