- (d) create effective procedures for the implementation and application of this Agreement and for the resolution of disputes.

The agriculture, forestry and fisheries is one of the areas identified in the Cooperation Chapter (or Chapter 9) of the Basic Agreement, and under the Chapter 4 of the Implementation Agreement, it requires the Ministry of Industry and Primary Resources of Brunei Darussalam and the Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry of Japan to establish the Dialogue Mechanism forum in order to:

o Reinforce the partnership between the two Ministries;

- Promote and strengthen agriculture, forestry and fisheries industries in both countries;
- Promote and enhance trade in agriculture, forestry and fishery products in both countries:
- Enhance diversification in Brunei Darussalam's economy through capacity building in the field of agriculture, forestry, fishery and food processing.

We are also delighted and honoured to be given the opportunity to host this 1<sup>st</sup> Meeting of the Dialogue Mechanism of MIPR and MAFF, here in Bandar Seri Begawan, Brunei Darussalam; which is also very timely when we, in Brunei Darussalam, are in the progress of advancing our agricultural activities and productivity in order to achieve our goals of sustainable food production and security.

The agriculture, fisheries and forestry industries in Brunei Darussalam is relatively small compared to those of Japan. - 4. *Cooperation* in Mangrove Conservation and Management : Japan's Experience

It was hoped that the Seminar will provide our participants and officials with a better insight and knowledge on how to move forward with our agriculture, forestry and fisheries development and management. The knowledge gained from the Seminar will pave the way to a well-coordinated agricultural, forestry and fisheries activities and development in Brunei Darussalam; taking into the consideration of its sustainability, environmental sound, food safety and security, and for our future generations.
